

Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on Thursday 5th March 2015:

The Parish Council met in the Village Hall @ 7pm. There were 4 Parish Councillors, 2 members of the public.

Unfortunately once again the Parish Council were not quorate for this meeting, so any financial, or planning decisions could not be made:

Open Forum: No topics for discussion.

County Councillors Report: Mr R. Gilbert reported that the lollipop persons are safe for another year and there is going to be a £100k cushion for the buses. Recycling, there is going to be a loss of income but it wont affect the collections of our waste. Council tax will be going up by approx. 44p per week for a band E property roughly a 1.99% increase.

District Councillors Report: The 106 Agreement has been decreased to 5 houses. SHDC won best customer service for the period 2014-2015.

General discussion

The school sign on the fence is to be moved although the 3 councillors present had no objection to it being where it is. Mrs A. Smith remarked on the subject of the vans being still parked on the corner of Lower Street. The work party date for the village clear up has been rescheduled for the 18th April, due to the lack of turn out for the last date.

The Village Hall Lease is with the Solicitors along with the new proposal by the VHC.
